OPEN SPACE INDEX:

Mr. White and Mr. Sousa reviewed the Open Space Index (last updated in 2013) and updates that have been made to update the index to be adopted for 2025.

Mr. White and Mr. Sousa have marked and reworded the sections that need to be changed along with the table of contents. Current references will need to have the punctuation mark (.) moved so that it doesn't look like it belongs to the next sentence.

FEMA preliminary update mapping has not been officially finalize and approved. A review of the section on federal wetlands states that they don't impose a specific buffer area.

A section has been added to the Parks and Recreation portion to be called Public Recreation vs. Non Recreational. This section is publically owned, but not recreation open space (not open to the public). Map number 7 will need to be updated by Lu Engineering.

- 5. Mr. Brand discussed the Town Board proposal for Cook Properties located on Rte 332 and County Road 41.
- 6. The solar farm on Commercial Drive is going forward.
- 7. Rte 96 and County Road 8 is also a solar farm.
- 8. 36 acre site located on Loomis Road an industrial park became known as Villager Construction.
